Wednesday 13 December - Year 8 trip to the British Library



We are delighted to be able to take our entire Year 8 cohort to The British Library on Wednesday 13 December for a learning experience created around the *Harry Potter: A History of Magic* exhibition.

Students will benefit from a dedicated school session designed to take Year 8s on an activity-led journey into the gallery, developing literacy and creativity and supporting cross-curricular learning. They will see 'magical' objects, rare books and manuscripts

from the British Library's collection along with original drafts and drawings by JK Rowling and illustrator Jay King. The exhibition and workshop has been designed to capture the traditions of folklore and magic which are at the heart of the Harry Potter stories.

Students should arrive at school at the normal time in full school uniform and should bring a packed lunch, those entitled to Free School Meals will be provided with a lunch on the day. They will travel to the British Library and back by coach arriving back at school around lunchtime.
