HPV Vaccines

Please note that HPV vaccinations (Human Papilloma Virus) are scheduled for Friday 8th June.

HPV is the name given to a very common group of viruses and there are many different types, some of which are called 'high risk' because they are linked to the development of cancers, such as cervical cancer. Other types can cause conditions such as warts or verrucas. The vaccine is effective at stopping girls from getting the types of HPV that cause most cervical cancers.

Girls aged 12 to 13 are routinely offered the first HPV vaccination when they are in Year 8. The second dose is offered 6 to 12 months after the first.

An assembly will be held for Year 8 girls about the HPV vaccinations in due course. In the meantime, please see the link below and the attached document for more information:
