Sports Day - Tuesday 9 July, National Sports Centre, Crystal Palace

We will be holding our annual Sports Day at the National Sports Centre, Crystal Palace. This is an exceptional opportunity for our pupils to participate in and to enjoy track and fields events at a national venue.

Tuesday 9th July is a registered school day; failure to attend Sports Day will be classed as an unauthorised absence. If a student is ill, please phone school as per usual to explain their absence.

Tuesday 9th July 2019

- Pupils will not arrive at school first
- Pupils will make their OWN way direct to the National Sports Centre to arrive from 08.30 with registration taken at 08.45 am. Pupils will be instructed on this journey during tutor time. A description of some journey routes are below.
- Everyone must also bring plenty of water, sun cream and waterproof clothing, just in case.
- Pupils will be dismissed from the ground from approximately 1pm, and are expected to make their own way home.

Clothing

Pupils will need to wear PE kit. This is to include the dark green jumper, green PE t-shirt and blue or black shorts/tracksuit trousers. Any pupil who attends the event in their own clothes will receive a restorative justice (RJ) detention.

Phones

Pupils will not be able to use their phones during the event, they can bring them and have them switched off in their bags. If a pupil is caught using their phone during sports day they will receive a red card and their phone will be confiscated until the event has finished. The teachers will be taking photos throughout the event, which will be shown to pupils in the following week.

Travelling to and from Crystal Palace National Sports Centre

There are trains to Crystal Palace from East Dulwich station that take around 20 minutes but tickets will need to be purchased. Pupils can get free travel on London Buses. The number 3 bus goes from Herne Hill to the Sports Stadium and takes around 30–40 minutes. The 197 goes from Underhill Road in East Dulwich to the Sports Stadium and the 176 goes from Melbourne Grove to the Sports Stadium too. The Stadium is a five-minute walk from the station or bus stop. Tutors will prepare their groups so that pupils will know how to travel safely to and from the venue. We advise pupils to travel with their friends. There will be staff at both North Dulwich and Crystal Palace stations to assist with questions. Please check to see which is the best route for your child.

The Friends of The Charter School will be at the event and will be selling refreshments; if pupils wish to purchase anything, please make sure that they bring small change with them.

Parents are most welcome to join us at Crystal Palace, but please note that Crystal Palace does not permit dogs anywhere inside the Stadium gated area.
