### ParentPay Auto Top-Up

In the new year, ParentPay will be launching Bank Transfer with Auto Top-up. This will enable parents to pay for lunches directly from their bank accounts and is guaranteed by the Direct Debit Service. When your child's balance falls below a certain amount, Bank Transfer with Auto Top-Up will allow you to select an amount that will automatically top-up the lunch balance.

### Food at The Charter School East Dulwich

From January 2018 the school food offering will change slightly: while we will continue to offer nutritionally balanced hot and cold meal deals at lunchtime, the range of foods available to purchase at break-time will increase.
