These will be considered before a formal planning application is submitted.

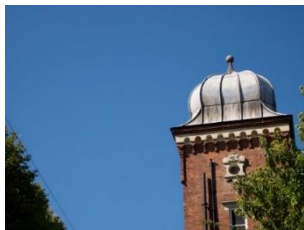

# The Charter School East Dulwich

The Charter School East Dulwich will be a co-educational, inclusive secondary school serving all communities near the school.

The Charter School Educational Trust's vision and ethos is for a community school serving the local area and it is expected that the majority of pupils will be within safe walking distance of the school. The school will be encouraging pupils to walk or cycle to school.

The design of the new school buildings will be carried out in close collaboration with our founding cohort of families and the wider community. The design will adhere to the following principles:

- The cultivation of useable outdoor space and the creation of a 'campus' feel
- The creation of healthy spaces for work and play, including the maximal use of natural light and good acoustics
- The provision of technology to enhance learning throughout the school site
- The enhancement of the local community through sympathetic and environmentally responsible and sustainable design
