Enrichment activities

This week students have been handed information about enrichment activities and asked to select the activities in which they wish to take part. Additionally, some enrichment activities that are externally run and require payment—for these activities you will be emailed and payments will be collected via our ParentPay system. A reminder that we ask that parents ensure they have spoken to their child so that they know exactly which activities they will be doing and what time they will be leaving school on each day. Reception will not be able to answer these questions on a student-by-student basis.

Open Days—Admissions for 2018

Our next round of Open Days begins on 19th September from 2-6pm. These events are aimed **only** at

parents with Year 6 students in our local Primary schools. We will be inviting Year 7 and 8 students to assist us in showing off our wonderful new school. Details to follow. **Forms will be sent home for parents to sign permission for students to stay behind for Open Days and be dismissed from the site at 6pm. For those staying, we ask that they bring in a packed lunch and snacks for the day. Free School Meal students will be provided with a packed lunch.**
