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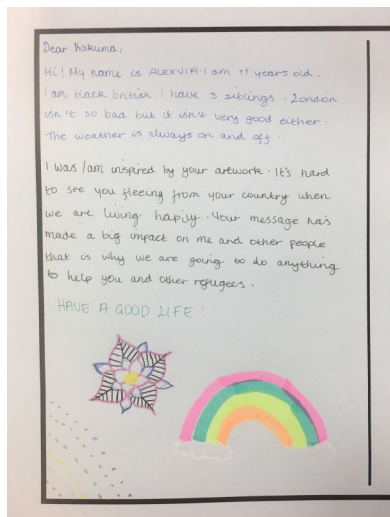
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TCSED Refugee Week

MyStart has been in school for TCSED Refugee Week this week. MyStart is a Creative Arts project in partnership with Gwa Africa. They run Art and film workshops in refugee camps and then the work that is produced at the camps is exhibited in UK schools.



MyStart allows young refugees to reclaim their sense of identity and purpose that has been lost in the abyss of war and suffering.

On Wednesday we were fortunate to have MyStart in the school to give assemblies to all TCSED students. The students then wrote some wonderfully reflective and supportive postcards to the young people who created the artworks and films in Kakuma.
