Uniform reminders for the remainder of this term, and the next:

Shoes:

<u>Plain black hard leather shoes</u> are to be worn. No canvas or trainers, soft black 'Vans', or 'Converse' of any description, or any other soft trainer-style footwear are to be worn. Plain black hard leather Kicker shoes are acceptable. Students who wear incorrect footwear, without a medical note, will receive a red card and be provided with alternative shoes by the school.

Coats and hats:

Hats (including baseball caps), tracksuit tops and hooded tops are not allowed in school. No logo jackets, no leather jackets, denim jackets or sportswear/tracksuit tops should be worn at any time.

Jewellery:

The only jewellery allowed in school is **one small pair of ear studs** that must be worn in the lobe of the ear.

For health and safety, and to avoid loss/theft:

- No other piercings are allowed
- No hooped or hanging earrings are allowed
- No necklaces or bracelets are allowed
- No rings are allowed

Make up may not be worn in Years 7–11 Including:

- No false eye lashes or nail extensions are to be worn.
- No coloured nail varnish

Hair must be of a natural colour, including any extensions.

From September:

Plain dark grey, dark green, navy or black **coats** and **bags** only. *Please note, this has been in our uniform policy since the beginning of the academic year.*
