Year 7 French Students' Trip to Boulogne-sur-Mer

We are delighted to announce that we will be taking our Year 7 French students on an end of year celebration trip to Boulogne-sur-Mer, France on Friday 5th July 2019.

We will leave school at 6:00am and travel by coach to Dover and expect to return at approximately 10:00pm. The day involves travelling from Dover to Calais across the English Channel by ferry. On arrival at Boulogne, students will have some free time in the old town to discover the history of Boulogne, and of course for those studying French this year to practise French in shops, a post office or cafés. Students will also visit Nausicaá Sea Life (the French National sea centre) where they will spend a couple of hours in the aquarium doing cross curricular work in biology and art.

The cost for the day is £71 (£50 for pupil premium), payable via ParentPay. The full payment must be made **by 17 May 2019**. Your child will need a valid UK/EU passport (valid for at least 6 months after the trip) and a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) for the duration of the visit. Please complete the consent form attached and return to the office with a copy of your child's passport (photo page) and EHIC.

While we will be arranging a reward trip for Spanish students next year, if your child would particularly like to join the French trip this year, please email the office with their details. While we cannot guarantee a place, we will let you know if any spaces are available after 17 May.

Please note that students' behaviour in school and during school trips this year will determine whether or not they are able to join this reward trip.
