Science Club in action - CSI Plants!

On Wednesday, curious investigators in Science Club were faced with a crime scene of an infestation on *Hedera helix* (common ivy). Students researched the potential attackers of the plant, identified them to be spider mites and then went on to collect the spider mites from the plants and view them under the microscope to confirm their findings. The plant pathologists also carried out comparative soil studies with a healthy plant to check for pH differences (if any). They discovered that the infested plant soil had an acidic pH. The pathologists have also drafted a letter to IKEA - the sellers of these plants, informing them of the sudden infestation of the plants which are only 7 weeks old and supported by our findings.

Science Club runs every Wednesday from 3.10 - 4.10pm. The Science department encourages students to join our team of budding scientists!
