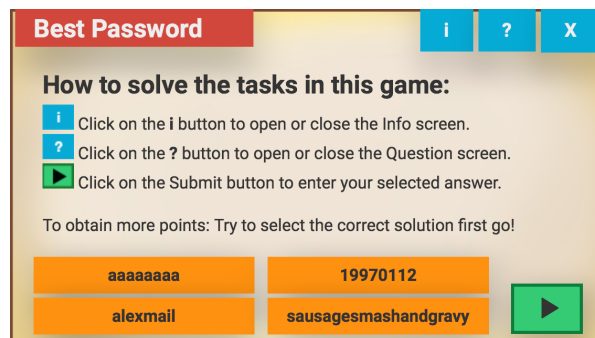
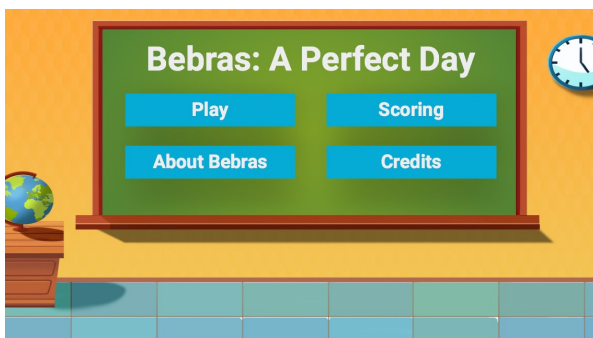
### Year 8 Boys Storm Through 1st Round of the Cup

Captain Endi Kika led the team well from the back being the safe pair of hands the team needed to keep Dunraven out of the game. Man of the match, Francis Sutton was relentless in his defence and never gave the opposition's strikers a moment's rest.

### UK Bebras Computational Thinking Challenge

Every year the University of Oxford runs a computational thinking challenge. The Bebras Computing Challenge introduces computational thinking to students. It is designed to get students all over the world excited about computing. The Bebras challenges are made of a set of short problems called Bebras tasks. The tasks are fun, engaging and based on problems that Computer Scientists often meet and enjoy solving. The tasks can be solved without prior knowledge but instead require logical thinking.

Every pupil will have the chance to take part during their Computing lessons the first week after Half Term. There is a Bebras App called 'Bebras: A Perfect Day' which can be downloaded free from the Google Play Store and Apple App Store; which pupils can download and practice their logical and problem solving skills. On the App there are 100 new computational thinking problems written by professional computer scientists from the international Bebras community.
