Handball London Youth Games

On Monday 3 February, our U13 and U15 boys took part in the Handball London Youth Games qualifiers, having already become the best team in Southwark. The U13 boys played against Whitmore School (Harrow) in the Last 16 of the London Youth Games. The winners will move on to the Last 8's Finals competition, taking place at the Copper Box Arena. The boys dominated throughout and came away 14-8 winners. This means that we will be going to the Handball Finals on 31 March. Well done to all the boys involved.



Next up were the U15 boys who were playing

in the last 32 of the London Youth Games against Hurlingham Academy (Fulham). Again, it was a very dominant display, with some high quality handball taking place. The boys ended up winning the game 16-9. This means they now set up a Last 16 match against Chelsea Academy on Thursday 12 March for a place in the Last 8's Finals, again at the Copper Box Arena. A huge well done to both teams.

The U13 Girls also have their Last 16 match coming up shortly (tbc). This means that we have the potential to have 3 teams in the London Youth Games Finals at the Copper Box which will be a fantastic achievement.



U15 Southwark Volleyball Tournament

On Wednesday 5 February we hosted the U15 Volleyball Tournament at our school. Eight teams entered the tournament, which is a record turn out. The tournament was split in to two round robin groups, with the top two from each group moving on to the semi finals. From the groups, three of our four Charter East teams made it to the semi finals.

From the semi finals: Charter East A were victorious 2-1 against Charter East C.

In the semi final 2: Charter North A were victorious 2-1 against Charter East B.

Next up for Charter East A is to attend the Volleyball London Youth Games Last 8's finals on Friday 6 March @UEL. Congratulations to all the boys that took part. Especially the year 8's and 9's who were playing in a much older age group. Our volleyball teams look very strong for the future.
