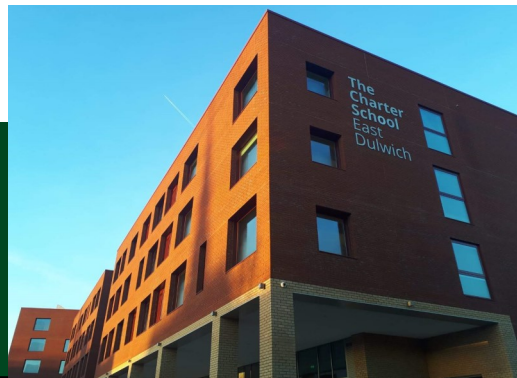

Football Boots Donations

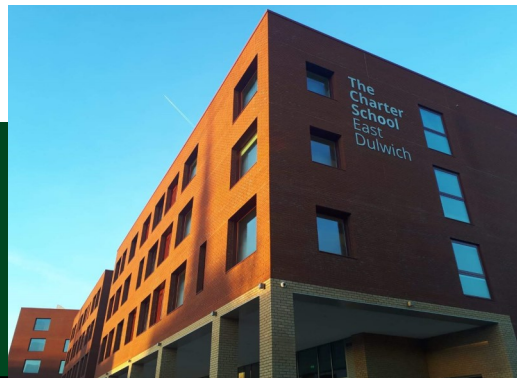
