What is the burden of air pollution on children's health?

The Charter School East Dulwich is part of the Dulwich and Herne Hill Safe Routes to School forum and they have arranged a FREE talk from Dr Ian Mudway, senior lecturer at the School of Population Health and Environmental Sciences at King's College London on the impact of air pollution on children's health.

Venue: Vaughan Williams Auditorium, James Allen's Girls' School, East Dulwich Grove, SE22 8TE

Dr Mudway has researched the impact of air pollution on human health for over 20 years, publishing over 100 research papers, reports and book chapters, as well as providing advice to local, national and international governments and NGOs. Currently his work is focused on understanding the early life impact of pollutants, particularly on the development of lung and cognitive function in children living in urban areas.
