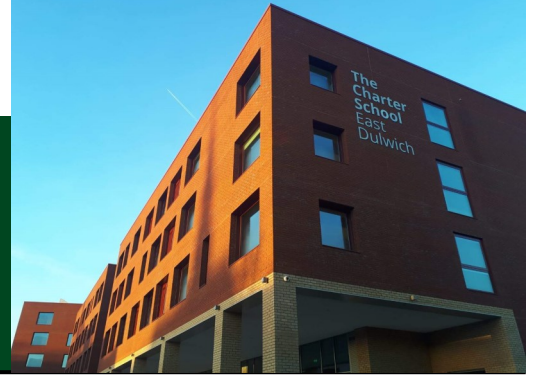
All absences must be reported for each day your child is off school, to the school office by 9.30 am, or the absence will be marked as unauthorised.

If your child is going to be absent due to a medical appointment or any other official appointments, then evidence is required. Failure to provide evidence will result in the absence being recorded as unauthorised.

Please also note that family holidays taken during term time are unauthorised. If you are planning to take your child on holiday for any reason, you must inform the school at least two weeks before departure.

Child Employment

A child may need a licence if they are under school leaving age and taking part in:

- films, plays, concerts or other public performances that the audience pays to see, or that take place on licensed premises
- any sporting events or modelling assignments where the child is paid

For these, we require a letter from your child's agency to the following email:

All child employment letters of request must be sent to the school office at least seven days in advance.
