Feed a Family this Christmas with Southwark Foodbank

The need for foodbanks goes up dramatically in the winter, with added costs like fuel and winter clothing for growing children putting pressure on some families to make ends meet. Southwark Foodbank are asking people to consider donating a mix of food and funds, to help families through the winter period. Therefore, we are supporting their *Feed a Family* campaign this year and are appealing to our school community to donate items of food direct to the school. Please note that the Foodbank already have an abundance of pasta, rice, soup etc... so we'd like you to donate items that make Christmas special, such as mince pies, snacks and nibbles, jam, custard, rice pudding, Christmas pudding, tinned fruit, Christmas cake, tinned pork meat, chocolate and treats as well as new children's books (age range 2 – 16 years old). Toiletries such as toothpaste, deodorant and shower gel are also needed.

Our Student Council will be gathering and sorting your donations between **Monday 2**nd **and Friday 19**th **December.** We will then deliver your donations to Southwark Foodbank in time for Christmas.

Southwark Foodbank also have a Just Giving page where money donations can be made. £50 will buy a gift card for a family this Christmas, £42 will feed a larger family with an emergency food parcel for 3 days, £33 a small family, £24 a couple, and £12.50 a single person. - **2.** These are for collection from the School on Saturday 7th December 10am 3pm. All trees will be ready to pick up from the school from the East Dulwich Grove entrance by the Gym/dining room. Please arrange to carry your tree away on foot as parking in the area is limited. All trees will come in nets for easy pick up.
