Dear parents,

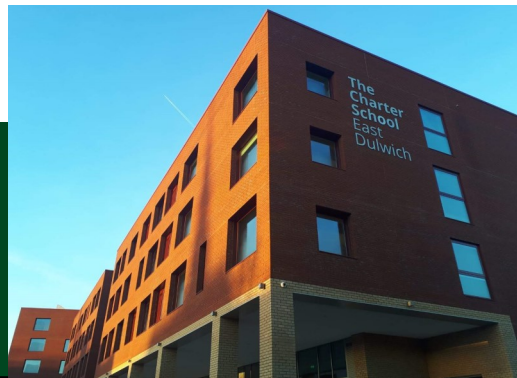
