Student safety in the community

Parents may have heard about an unfortunate incident that took place at the end of the school day on Monday. Three of our students were subject to intimidation by two young men not known to the school. The incident took place on Melbourne Grove. No physical contact took place and no student was injured, but this was clearly upsetting for the students involved. When these sorts of incident occur it is important that parents are kept fully informed with the facts of the situation, rather than forced to rely on often-exaggerated hearsay. For the avoidance of doubt, school staff were at their assigned duty points throughout the incident. School staff effectively cleared the street of students within minutes of the incident taking place. The school is actively engaged with the parents of the students involved to ensure their ongoing welfare. The school has also contacted the police in relation to the incident and is supporting the police with their inquiries.

The school will take very seriously any attempt to intimidate its students and will protect them as best it is able from disputes that may arise between young people outside of school. We would encourage any parent concerned about their child's associations outside of school to contact the school for a discussion in confidence.


Our Very Own Alex Bayly releases his debut album - launch Weds 30th Oct

This week has been busy for the eco-team. Firstly, the declaration of the school's climate emergency was presented to the governors. As well as recognising the severity and urgency of the current global situation, it states that the school pledges to: take steps in order to make the school and community more carbon neutral, pressurise businesses and the government to take climate change more seriously and make climate change and sustainability a



significant part of the school curriculum. This presentation was followed a few days later with a solar panel workshop for members of the eco-team. The visitors from energy providers REL and Daikin spoke to the students about the steps they took in order to make the school's energy use more sustainable. Students were also taken up to the roof to see the solar panels and were given a demonstration about how they were built and how they worked.
