Invitation from the Eco-Friends: Car-Free Sunday 22 September

This Sunday Tower Bridge and most of the City of London will be closed to traffic for a car-free day. The Eco Friends invite you to join a bike ride led by Alex Howard, starting from the school entrance on Jarvis Road, at 11am, and touring the empty roads of central London, and back to Melbourne Grove (also car-free from 3-6pm), at 3pm for ice cream! Bring a packed lunch for a picnic (this may be on Tower Bridge if not too busy) and flags, bells and whistles.

Southwark-to-the-Sea Walk: Sunday, 29 September

Join us for TCSED's annual Southwark-to-the-Sea Walk. This is a one-day walk every September, from 2017 to 2022 following the Thames from London to the Sea.

This year, we'll be walking the Kentish Thames path, passing through Dartford Marshes, ducking under Queen Elizabeth bridge, continuing past a derelict power station and via the ancient village of Northfleet, and finishing our walk at historic Gravesend - the real Pocahontas is buried here and Charles Dickens set many a scene in pubs, cottages and marshes in and around the town.

Join us for the full 13.2 mile walk from 10am to 6pm, Dartford to Gravesend, or, for the shorter walk of 6.2 miles from 2pm to 6pm from Greenhithe to Gravesend. We'll catch the train back from Gravesend to London at around 6pm.

Meeting points:

- 10am at Dartford Station (direct from Peckham Rye)
- 2pm at Greenhithe station (a short train or bus journey from Dartford Station)
