Autumn Term Enrichment

We are delighted to be launching our Enrichment Programme with a wide range of activities for students to select for the Autumn Term, we would like to encourage all students to apply for at least 2 clubs.

Please look over the schedule attached to this email with your child over the weekend so that they are prepared to complete their online application during tutor time on Monday and Tuesday; catch-up sessions will be available in the library during lunch. Please note that some clubs have limited numbers and places will be allocated via a random draw with consideration given to whether students have already had the opportunity to take part.

Please note that while the majority of our clubs are free, Steel Pans, Track Cycling and Tennis are paid for clubs. Students should apply during tutor time but places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis via payment on <u>ParentPay</u>.

- Track Cycling is held at Herne Hill Velodrome. Lessons are £50 per term.


News from The Friends of TCSED
