Accessing Google Classroom at home

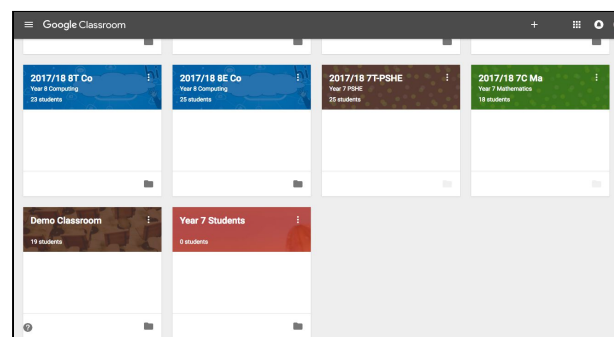
There are two ways to access Google Classroom at home.

For Students

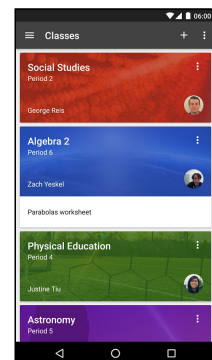
Google Classroom Online

- 1) Visit <http://classroom.google.com>
- 2) Log in using your child's school email account (ending in @chartereastdulwich.org.uk)
- 3) Once logged in, all classes will be displayed. Click on the title of the class to view classwork and homework.
- 4) Within Google Documents all work is automatically saved while working on the document. There is no need to save or email work once completed.



Google Classroom App

- 1) Visit your App store and search for Google Classroom
- 2) Log in using your child's school email account (ending in @chartereastdulwich.org.uk)
- 3) All classes, class and homework will now be visible.
- 4) All work completed on the phone will save when completed.
