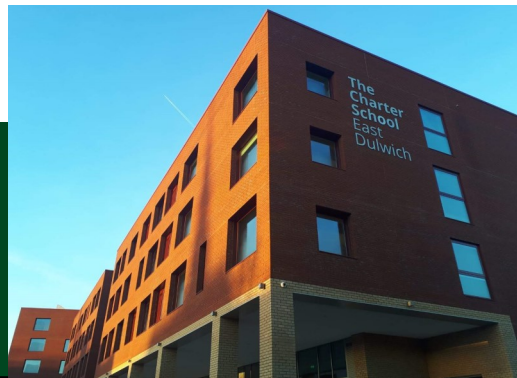
Careers Update

A brief update for now: during this key term for post-GCSE pathways, our Careers focus has been on Yr 11 applications for 6th forms, colleges and apprenticeships. Yr 10: we shall be announcing our plans for work experience shortly after Easter. All Yr 10 students are having an "Introduction to FE" session with Southwark College this week, where they can explore courses and applications. Yr 9: almost all students have now had their first Careers Guidance 1:1, exploring what happens after GCSEs and looking into studies or careers of interest. Yr 8: all students will have an "Introduction to University" session shortly after Easter, presented by St Anne's College, Oxford. Tutor Time Careers Talks will return in May for every year group; our next focus areas are using languages at work and the Creative sector.
