


# Sixth Form Bulletin vol.1

#### Taster Lessons and Summer Homework

Most of you joined our online Taster Lessons or were able to watch the recorded versions we circulated after the event. Don't forget these recordings are still available (in accompanying PDF attached to this email) and it would be worth revisiting these videos to refresh yourself on the subjects you have chosen.

At Enrolment, you will be given compulsory summer homework that you will need to complete for the first week in September. This is a piece of work designed to help you transition from Year 11 to Year 12. Your teachers will mark this work and give feedback in order to help you understand the difference between GCSE and A level work.


#### Is there a dress code?

# Building update


The Sixth Form Space and Study area for September 2021 is an outstanding facility at the top floor of the main teaching block. With impressive views, designated study and charge points, equipped with chromebooks, printer, and resources for work experience & UCAS / careers - it's a highly modern workspace. A dedicated, attractive and functional hub to encourage mature, independent study and address the needs of our young adults as they join the Sixth Form.

There has been dramatic progress made on the demolition of the old hospital to make way for Phase Two of our school buildings. In September 2021, there will be three multi-games areas for playing sports. During 2022, the Victorian 'chateau' building will be refurbished and another modern block completed which will house office space and further school facilities including a drama and music suite. The pandemic had some impact on the timescale, but building is now underway with speed and we plan to update you regularly on progress.

## Bursary

At the Sixth Form we offer a Bursary, to students aged 16–19 who are most in need (care leavers, students in care, students claiming Income Support, disabled young people who receive an Allowance). In addition, we support other students who face genuine financial difficulties. Students who are eligible can apply for a maintenance bursary and receive regular payments and / or a one-off payment to help with a specific item.

We are very keen that all students who may require support are not disadvantaged and feel able and supported to apply for financial assistance. In September, a Bursary application and Free School Meals application are required to apply for the funds.
