Parent Information Sessions: Mental Health Support

Kooth, a digital mental health provider which offers a free, confidential and safe way for young people to access support online, are running parent information sessions in June 2021. Kooth offer young people the ability to access online counselling from BACP qualified counsellors through a 1-1 chat session via drop in or booked sessions, access to peer to peer support on premoderated discussion boards and an online magazine with moderated articles offering advice and guidance on a range of topics.

These sessions are designed to help parents and carers understand how Kooth could support their child with their mental health and well-being. They will also outline Qwell, the equivalent adult service, to introduce parents and carers to flexible well-being support.

Each session will include a presentation on Kooth, a live tour of the Kooth site, an introduction to Qwell and an opportunity for Questions & Answers about both services.
