They will work with the local community to develop a large-scale artwork for the centre's reception area, which will be revealed in August 2021.

TCSED Creative Arts are delighted to be involved in an exciting collaboration between Dulwich Picture Gallery and our neighbours - The Tessa Jowell Health Centre. The collective consists of artists: Bamidele Awoyemi, Farouk Agoro and Livia Wang who have been running a series of creative workshops with the centre's service users, staff and the local community. As part of the workshop, our students will be given an insight into the artists' backgrounds in architecture, design and art, and they will then go on to design their own unique patterns which will inform a 'quilt' design that will adorn the glass balustrade within the atrium of the reception area.
