Destinations

As a brand new Sixth Form, we do not have leavers as yet, but to give you an idea of where students from our sibling school have headed off to, students from Charter North Dulwich have in the recent past gone to destinations ranging from Oxford and Cambridge, Russell Group universities such as Manchester and Birmingham, and Higher Level Apprenticeships such as MACE Construction.

We have appointed a Trust-wide Leader in Higher Education. Fiona Lucas has spent many years successfully supporting North Dulwich students through the UCAS process. She will now be leading on this across both schools to ensure that all Sixth Formers receive excellent guidance on the next stage in their education.

We will work with organisations to support students from a disadvantaged background into university, such as www.suttontrust.com and www.theelephantgroup.org.

We will also have an Oxbridge and Medicine programme of support for students who are intending to apply to Oxbridge or for Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Science. The school has close links with St Anne's College in Oxford and Pembroke College in Cambridge, and we will run visits, talks and workshops with admissions tutors. Medical applicants will benefit from our links with King's College Hospital. All students who are interested in applying to highly selective courses are encouraged to participate in a broad range of super-curricular activities and we will run a programme of events throughout Sixth Form to ensure they are well prepared for the application process.

The Oxbridge and Medicine programme includes:

- A series of talks from teachers and visiting speakers addressing students on a range of challenging academic topics and debates.
- Super-curricular academic clubs in current affairs, debating, maths and physics, history, poetry etc.
- University visits and lectures.
- Workshops and one-on-one advice on writing a strong personal statement and completing UCAS.
- Support with preparing for the Aptitude Tests which are taken for Oxbridge and Medicine.
- Support with interview skills, including arranging mock interviews.



Curriculum Enrichment

We hope you have been checking emails and clicking through to various course enrichments and lecture opportunities we have been sending through.

These are beneficial for your studies and future applications – so be sure to register and attend the relevant ones for your interests and courses, now while you have time on your hands.

In case you've missed them, next few coming up include **The Young Economists' Conference** on 7 July and an **Art History A Level** opportunity from September.

During your time as a Sixth Former, there will also be a full programme of extra-curricular opportunities that include Gold Duke of Edinburgh, sports clubs, history symposium, Smart Law mock trials and many more. These are in addition to work experience and career opportunities, as well as your UCAS and apprenticeship pathway support.
