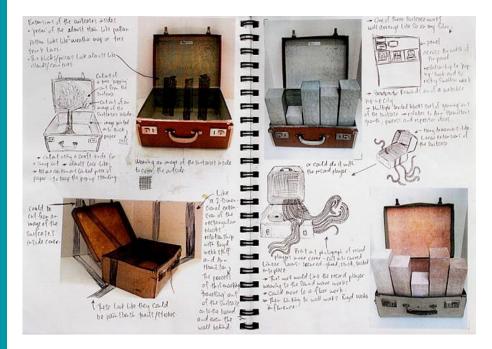
## DT summer homework: Product analysis
