A group of students attended the launch this week of The Elephant Group, an outstanding access initiative to increase the number of students from non-selective schools attending top universities. The group travelled to Bloomsbury for the event that outlined the support network and programme available to them over the next two years.

Oxbridge and Early Entry

Target Oxbridge is a free programme that aims to help black African and Caribbean students and students of mixed race with black African and Caribbean heritage increase their chances of getting into the Universities of Oxford or Cambridge. Our students who qualify have been informed about the programme and are enlisting if they are interested and qualify.

Our Early Entry Group has also been launched and our students who are keen, interested and able to apply for Oxford or Cambridge, or who are interested in studying medicine or veterinary science at university, have been contacted and informed about the choices and what will be required of them over the coming 18 months.

Also launched this term are two specific Google Classrooms – Medicine and Super Curricular – each provides a rich resource of the activities that students should be undertaking now and will form a key component of their UCAS applications next year.

Congratulations are due to Finn Ogbe who has succeeded in winning an Arkwright Engineering Scholarship. As well as a monetary award with funding to support his engineering project, Finn is paired with a Professional Mentor to support future study and career development. The award is highly competitive and we are very proud of Finn and his success.
