- Which teacher do I like?




#### Core Subjects



All students across the country have to study a set of core subjects



- ☑ GCSE English Literature
- GCSE English Language
- ☑ GCSE Mathematics
- ✓ GCSE Science Double Science (2 GCSEs) or Triple Science (3 GCSEs)
- ☑ PE (does not lead to qualification)



Students who are certain that they want to pursue a career in Science and who are averaging a grade 6 or higher in Science will be offered the opportunity to study GCSE Triple Science (equivalent to three GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics).



#### EBacc



The English Baccalaureate is recognised by Post 16 and Further Education. You gain it by getting a Grade 4+ in... **ENGLISH MATHS** HIS / GEOG **LANGUAGE SCIENCE** 

The vast majority of our students take the EBacc, if there's a reason not to this can be discussed in your meeting and with families.






#### **Option Blocks**

#### Progress 8



When you finish your GCSEs in Year 11 you end up with four important pieces of information:

- 1. GCSE Grades across all your subjects (Graded 9 to 1)
- 2. GCSE English and Maths Grades You must gain Grade 4+ in both
- 3. EBacc qualification
- 4. Progress 8 Score

Progress 8 Score is a number calculating how well you have achieved compared to other students across the country of the same ability.





#### Progress 8




Progress 8 Score calculates how well you have achieved compared to other students across the country

Compares your average Grade across your best 8 **-0.2** +0.5 subjects that fit into the 'buckets' and gives you a score 6 **BEST MATHS BEST** HIS or MFL **Everything Else SCIENCE GEOG ENGLISH** DRAMA **BTEC SPORT GEOG**



# **Options Meetings**

Staff have student progress info before hand to help guide decisions – eg Triple Science, SEND

Students emailed google form
