## How will we support your children?





- **Pastoral system** 20 minutes tutor time every morning and one hour extended tutor or whole-cohort assembly each week providing students with spiritual, moral and social communication skills as well as supporting character education.
- **'Vertical' Tutoring** from 2017-18 students will be in mixed age tutor groups where older students mentor and support younger students.
- Students will be organised into **House System**: four school houses that maintain a tight sense of community and education on a human scale.
- **'Student Voice'** a full programme of activities to ensure our students have a say in how their school develops, eg. school council members, student librarians, 'curriculum advisors' and recruitment specialists.

- Services home at 3.00pm and 4.30pm




## Supported access to public transport

#### How will we build our new school?




The Trust has appointed as main scheme architects/design consultants **Feilden Clegg Bradley Studios.**
